

PROTEK What Wood Stain?

At Protek our products are basically separated in to two categories.

- 1. Wood Preserver to preserve and protect timber against rot and fungi
- 2. **Wood Stains** that **colour** and create a **waterproof** coating to protect against the elements

We do not include preservative chemicals in all of our products as a lot of timber comes pre-treated. By separating out the preservative process it means we are not using chemicals unnecessarily thus giving the environment another helping hand.

What Wood Stain to Use and Why?

Wood Preserver should be used for preserving timber and the only product we recommend for decking is **Decking Stain**.

SHED & FENCE




- basic economy
- water-based equivalent to creosote type products
- traditional natural looking matt stain finish
- thin stain that soaks in to the timber
- resins & waxes make it water-repellent
- annual re-treatment to maintain level of repellency
- suitable for vertical softwood surfaces

WOOD STAIN & PROTECTOR •







- range of 36 colours from wood tones to primary & heritage shades with matt finish
- soft, flexible wood stain coating that penetrates top of timber then creates coating on top
- resins make it water-repellent
- lasts 2 4 years depending on levels of wear & tear plus exposure
- suitable for vertical softwood surfaces

VOOD STAIN



- high-grade joinery product superior to Wood Stain & Protector
- water-based equivalent to Sadolin & Ronseal type products
- opaque satin finish in 58 colours coating doesn't look as dense and thick as a wood paint
- thick paint-like consistency. Stain penetrates top layers of timber & creates coating on top
- acrylic resin & polyurethane from linseed oil make it highly water-repellent & hard-wearing
- lasts 2 5 years depending on levels of wear & tear plus exposure
- suitable for horizontal & vertical surfaces plus softwood and hardwood

STABLE COAT



- high-grade advanced wood stain
- water-based equivalent to creosote type products
- traditional natural looking matt stain finish
- thin stain that soaks into the timber so can't be kicked off by horses
- acrylics & hydrophobic additive make it highly water-repellent
- annual re-treatment to maintain level of repellency
- suitable for vertical softwood surfaces
